Some of these children reside in the Home on a full-time basis, others are there for the supplementary tutoring program we offer during the day. After taking an hour-time to play, nap or just relax from the school day, the children are then set to study and do their homework, aided by two tutors that we provide.

This year, the Home opened its door to a lovely boy by the name of Noor el Deen who comes to us from a Moslem family. This family is living in very poor conditions and constant fighting because of the location of their inhabitation in the city of Nablus (Shekem). Noor el Deen is very grateful to be at the Home of New Life in Ramallah, and to have the chance to receive nurture and nourishment as well as a better education. We pray also that, as he is within our care, he will taste the goodness and riches of our Lord, the reviver of our spirit and restorer of our souls, and that he will be able to receive spiritual nourishment for which we all are desperate.

This is all made possible by God's grace and faithfulness in using whatever you have placed in His hands and blessing it into abundance. We want to express strongly our appreciation for your faithfulness and persistence and we encourage you to be fruitful in the Lord's work and never to hold back because the Lord is faithful and will multiply!

- ◆ for renewed trust in the hand of the Lord to uphold us through the unknown future and to sustain our every need.


We have much to praise God for! We are seeing His hand move on all what we do. May the Lord bless you and have a wonderful month.
